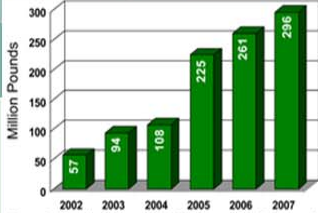

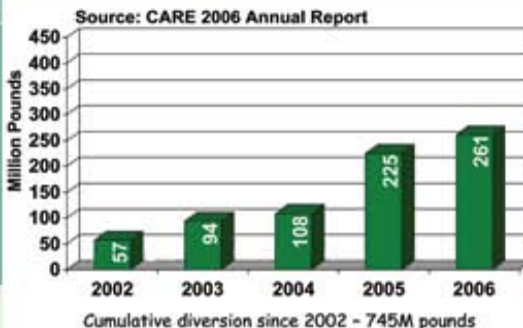

Carpet America Recovery Effort (CARE) is a joint industry-government effort to increase the amount of recycling and reuse of post-consumer carpet and reduce the amount of waste carpet going to landfills. CARE was established as a result of a Memorandum of Understanding for Carpet Stewardship (MOU), a national agreement signed by members of the carpet industry, representatives of government agencies at the federal, state and local levels, and non-governmental organizations.

CARE Mission Statement: CARE's mission is to develop market-based solutions for recovering value from discarded carpet to meet the goals of the negotiated outcomes.

To accomplish its mission, CARE facilitates, advises, provide resources, and serves as a forum for the many different stakeholders.

CARE is funded and administered by the carpet industry, which agrees to use CARE to:

Enhance the collection infrastructure for post-consumer carpet.

Serve as a resource for technical, economic and market development opportunities for recovered carpet.

Develop and perform quantitative measurement and reporting on progress toward the national goals for carpet recovery.

Work collectively to seek and provide funding opportunities for activities to support the national goals for carpet recovery.

This group educates consumers on the danger of carpet in our landfills. Most carpet is made from oil, a rapidly depleting and increasingly dangerous and expensive resource.

Discarded carpet is becoming a multi-million dollar property liability. Landfill charges will likely double every 5 years or so now. The actual cost of new carpet is still far less inflated than almost any other industry. However, other costs associated with carpet replacement, such as removal, installation, disposal, transportation, and regulation have created a demand for environmentally sensible alternatives. For landfill costs alone, one company has calculated their cost to exceed \$4 million over 10 years.

It's time to reduce, reuse, and recycle.

We encourage those concerned with how carpet disposal affects our environment, as well as those in the flooring industry to share stories, facts, and ideas about keeping our landfills safe!
